Kostelec nad Orlicí chateau will host puppets and designs made for theatres in Berlin, Norwich and Nurnberg, designs for Kaikyo Drama Museum and works related to Dutch Noah's Arch project that is currently under way.

More than 80 wood-carved puppets, designs and hand-sketched scripts for puppet shows.

Puppets and designs for Prague Tineola Theatre collected over the past 11 years.

Along with puppets, the exhibition will present also other Michaela Bartoňová's artworks – oil paintings and graphics inspired by her Australian stay, illustrations, graphics and paintings for children etc. The exhibition will be composed of several thematic areas presented as settings from the produced shows e.g. Étain – inspired by Celtic myths; Haywain – inspired by Hieronymus

Bosch's paintings; Faust Metamorphoses – fusion of characters from Goethe's Faust, "Boschian" archetypes and selected poetic texts; Around the World in a Tea Kettle – a story by Edward Lear, a painter and adventurer, served as an inspiration for a puppet journey of Kudykam and Tudytam sailing the world in a tea kettle. In 2010, the show was a great success in Abu Dhabi, having been previously performed also in many German towns and cities (e.g. Berlin, Munich, Dachau, Trier, Wolfsburg)

How to Make a Puppet section of the exhibition will show the puppet making process from subject research to sketching and designing, carving, hand-sketched scripts etc. 2010/11 will be represented by works for Noah's Arch – from sketches to life-sized characters of the Old Testament.

On Saturday, July 9, the exhibiting artist will hold Let the Shadows Dance creativity workshop for children and parents.

On Sunday, July 10, Dot to Picture creativity workshop for adults and teenagers will be held – in 4 hours you will be able to paint a mid-sized canvas entirely of your own making.

The exhibition will be closed with From Tarot Cards to Painting to Yourself workshop for adults, including those who think they can't draw – painting a white canvas (50x50cm).
